

English

The children will be starting to apply a range of grammar features taught in different writing genres. We will be writing a postcard from Pompeii, describing a book or film character as well as producing a non-chronological report.

Reading

We will be using our text to develop our prediction, inference, questioning, summarising and evaluating skills.



Maths

In Year 3, the children will start by adding and subtracting across tens before starting to recognise and become familiar with numbers up to 1000. We will continue with this learning and incorporate exploring measuring weight, length and height.



PSHCE

Children explore the connection between mental and physical health. They learn how emotions affect the body, how to recognise feelings in others, and why sleep is important for wellbeing.

History

Children will be exploring the reaches of the Roman Empire on Britain and the lasting effects that we can still see today such as Roman roads and Hadrian's Wall.

Year 3



Art

In Art Year 3 -4 will be focussing on how artists create tone, texture and scale. We will be practising these skills and drawing still life to demonstrate what we have learned. We will also enjoy designing and making Roman shields



Science

This unit introduces pupils to how the human body works, focusing on nutrition, skeletons and muscles. Pupils learn about the five food groups and why a balanced diet is important for staying healthy.



Computing

Children will explore how information is shared online and how to stay safe when using the internet. They will also learn to distinguish between facts, opinions and beliefs.



French

In French we will be learning all about France and the basics of how to greet and how you introduce yourself.



RE

In this unit, pupils explore key Christian beliefs about God as Creator and the relationship between God and humanity. Through studying the Creation and Fall in Genesis, the Ten Commandments and the parable of the Lost Son.
