

English

Children will use *The Railway Children* to inspire their writing. They'll practise using inverted commas in dialogue and write emotive letters from characters' perspectives. Drama will help explore emotions and bring scenes to life. They will also enhance descriptive writing by imagining new homes, like the characters in the story.

We are reading



Reading

Once by Morris Gleitzman, set during WWII, helps children build reading skills while exploring history. Pupils will practise predicting, clarifying vocabulary, and analysing characters, while engaging with themes like courage, friendship, and resilience.



Maths

This term, children will strengthen their understanding of place value and practise the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. They'll use practical and written methods to solve problems and build confidence in applying these skills across different contexts.



PSHCE

Children will learn how to live a healthy lifestyle, they will look at food packaging, think about how they care for their teeth and talk about their feelings.

History

In History this term, children will be learning about how World War II began and the key events that shaped it. They'll explore what life was like for evacuees, imagining how children felt being sent away from home. We'll also look at the impact of the Blitz on everyday life and how the roles of women changed during the war, helping pupils understand how society adapted in challenging times.

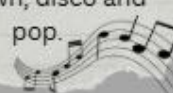
Computing

Children will learn how to stay safe online by understanding internet safety rules, protecting personal information, recognising risks, and knowing what to do if something doesn't feel right.



Music

In Music the children will focus on learning to read basic musical notation with a genre focus of Motown, disco and pop.



Science

This term we will be learning about electricity. The children will create their own circuits and then adapt them to find new ways to make things happen, such as how to make a bulb brighter. They will also look at how electricity is useful in the modern world.



Art

In Art, the children will look into Street Art as well as various drawing techniques. They will design a piece of graffiti linking to saving the planet, look at how to draw from a one point perspective and upscale a picture.



RE

In R.E. this term, children will be learning about Buddhism, focusing on the Eightfold Path and the concept of enlightenment. They'll explore how Buddhists aim to live a balanced and mindful life, and reflect on how these teachings influence everyday choices and behaviour.
