Who will be teaching your children?

St Francis – Mrs Margetson and Mrs Dutta.

St Teresa – Mr Smigielski.

Mr Rides will be our year group teaching assistant and will be working across both classes.

Which classroom will my child be in?

St Francis will be based in the classroom behind you. The door on the left.

St Teresa will be based in the other classroom behind you on your right.

Where do I drop off and pick up?

Children will line up in the mornings outside the hall door and be dismissed at the end of the day through the doors at the top of the slope.

Doors open at 8:30am and lessons will start promptly at 8:40am.

Our school day finishes at 3:10pm.

Uniform

Same uniform expectations as the Infants school with the addition of a *school tie and dark grey jumper* which can be ordered from Price & Buckland. School shoes only, *no trainers*.

On PE days, children must wear their house colour t-shirt, black shorts or trousers and suitable *black* trainers. If the weather is cold, they may wear a black hoodie with the school logo on.

Please ensure all uniform is labelled so that if it goes missing, we can locate it easier.



Lunches



If you are wanting your child to have hot school meals, they need to be ordered through the online system. They are now only free if you are entitled to free school meals.

If not, you will need to supply your child with a packed lunch. We are a nut free school, so nothing including nuts as we have children with allergies.

Children are encouraged to have a water bottle in class-just water.

Children may have a snack at break time, we recommend a piece of fruit.

Expectations



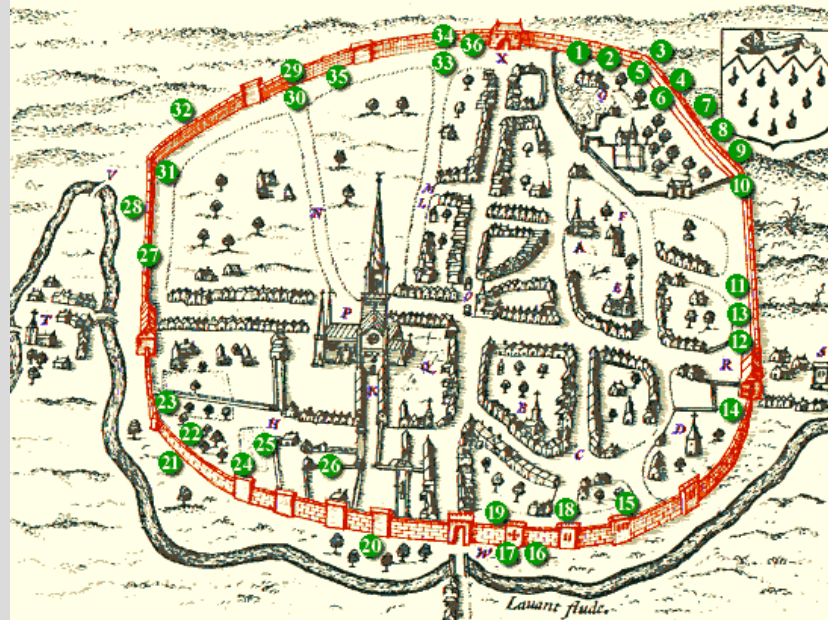
Equipment
