## **PRIOR KNOWLEDGE:**

## **Enquiry Questions:**

- 1. What is a tapestry? In which era were they popular? Are there any common themes within them? What is their purpose?

- 4. Plan, design and draw your image using isometric paper. Remember you piece must follow a theme as it will be connected to the others.
- 5. Can you make your cross stitch piece?
- 6. Can you critically evaluate your piece?

CONTEXT: Chn to create a class, collage cross stitch. They have previous experience of sewing when making blankets. This will differ in that they will now be experimenting with sewing in an aesthetic sense.

- Chn will learn a new type of sewing cross stitching
- They will know that cross stitching differs from sewing as it is an aesthetic activity, rather than a practical activity
- Chn will know that sewing has been used throughout history for various purposes
- Chn will be able to discuss the features of tapestries, citing their purposes at various points in history
